



## Family Still Seeking Answers 4 Years after Tulsa County Man's Disappearance



36 year old Jarral Ray Osburn, better known as "JR", was last seen on August 28, 2012 at the Walgreen's at 12802 East 96<sup>th</sup> Street North in Owasso. Records show his cell phone was used through the early morning hours of the 29<sup>th</sup>, and then all activity stopped. Just before 8:00am on the 29<sup>th</sup>, Tulsa County Deputies found his 1994 Oldsmobile CLS abandoned in the area of 6510 North Cincinnati Ave.

Osburn failed to show up to work at Spirit Aerosystems. His family lives in Kansas and grew concerned after not hearing from him. They checked the RV Park where Jarral lived alone near 209<sup>th</sup> West Avenue. After finding no sign of him, Osburn's family reported him as missing to Sand Springs Police on September 18<sup>th</sup>, 2012.

Sand Springs Police and the TCSO are actively investigating Osburn's disappearance. At this point, it appears he met with foul play. Investigators believe there are people who know what happened to Osburn, but they have refused to cooperate.

In an effort to generate new leads, JR's family will travel from Kansas to the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office this Saturday at 1:00pm to speak with the media.
