



## **SHERIFF REGALADO HIRES DAVID PARKER AS JAIL ADMINISTRATOR**

The Tulsa County Sheriff's Office is proud to welcome David Parker as Jail Administrator at David L Moss beginning April 17<sup>th</sup>.

Parker brings more than three decades of Oklahoma Department of Corrections experience to the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office. He retired from the DOC as Regional II Director earlier this month.

Parker began his career with the DOC in 1986, as a corrections officer at the James Crabtree Correctional Center. During his years at JCCC, Parker consistently rose through the ranks. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice from Northwestern Oklahoma State University in 1996. The following year he was promoted to Regional Investigator for the Northern Region, where he served until transferring to the West Central Region as Administrative Assistant in 1998. In 2001, he was promoted to Deputy Warden at Joseph Harp Correctional Center. In April 2006, Parker returned the James Crabtree Correctional Center as Warden. He served in that position until 2012, when he was appointed as Region II Director for the DOC.
