Arrest in Turley Shooting

TCSO detectives arrested Joshua Wildcat for this morning's drive by shooting of a 33 year old woman in Turley.

Detectives believe today's shooting is retaliation for an incident at the same address in 2010. Wildcat was a suspect in a burglary in which a second suspect was killed by the homeowner. The death was ruled a justifiable homicide. The 2010 report is attached below.

Deputy's Summary:

On 04/01/10 at about 2155 hours I was radio dispatched to investigate a report of a 1st Degree Burglary in progress and a shooting at 6017 N Owasso Ave. I was advised by the dispatcher that the reporting party at this location had arrived home to find an intruder, had shot the intruder, and that the reporting party believed that the intruder was dead.

Reporting Party summary:

Michael Clayton Lish Jr. stated that on the evening of 04/01/10 he and his wife Marianna Lish returned home to find that their back door which they had closed and locked when they left 10-25 minutes earlier was open. Michael Lish stated that he was carrying a .45 caliber semi-automatic handgun and possessed a concealed carry license. Lish stated that he drew the weapon and entered the residence through the open back door entering the kitchen. Lish stated that when he entered he could hear movement from someone inside the bedroom area of the house. Lish passed through a curtain dividing the kitchen from the living room and looked around the corner into the bedroom. Lish stated that he came face to face with a man dressed in dark clothing and holding a large broadsword that was owned by Lish. Lish aimed the weapon at the suspect and stated, "Halt, don't move." Lish stated that the man responded by stating, "I'm gonna slit your throat," and advanced on both Lish and his wife. Lish stated that he fired one round at the suspects chest and the suspect fell to his knees. Lish stated that the sword flew from the suspects hands and landed on the bed behind him. Lish stated when the suspect fell he was able to see past the suspect into the bedroom. At this time he observed that a 9 MM pistol that he owned was missing from the bed headboard where he kept it. The suspect began to reach for his back pants pocket and Lish stated that he was afraid that the suspect had taken this weapon and was now reaching for it. Lish stated he fired a second time at the suspects chest. The suspect fell to his stomach and then reared up while continuing to reach for his back pants pocket. Lish stated that he then fired a third time at the suspects chest and the suspect fell prone. Lish stated that the suspect was laying on the floor blocking his path to the home phone and was still slightly moving. Seeing that the path to the phone was blocked Lish stated that he told his wife, Marianne, to go to a neighbor's house and call the police.

Witness Summary #1:

[REDACTED] stated that she heard Marianne Lish in the street screaming for help. She then went out into the street where they found Marianne Lish crying and stating that her husband had just shot a man. [REDACTED] stated that she saw the suspect through the open front door of the residence after he had been shot. [REDACTED] stated that she thought she had seen the person around Turley before but did not know who he was.

Witness Summary #2:

[REDACTED] stated that she is Michael Lish's sister. Garwick stated that she is visiting her mother at 5953 N Owasso and that her true residence is in Aberdeen, WA. [REDACTED] stated that she heard Marianna Lish screaming that her husband, Michael had shot an intruder in their home. Garwick stated that she is a nurse and went into the residence to see if she could help him. [REDACTED] stated that the suspect was breathing shallowly and then gave a death gurgle and she could no longer feel a pulse. [REDACTED] stated that she then went back outside to wait for the police to arrive.
