Undersheriff Robinette,

This data analysis extends from January 1st through December 31st of 2015. I am pleased to report there were a total of 25 investigated events. In comparison to 2013 (August to August) there were 28 events. Also in 2015, there were 8 unsubstantiated allegations, 11 substantiated allegations, and 6 unfounded allegations. In all cases some type of mitigation was taken. In all cases immediate action was taken to separate suspects and victims. There were no events of officers sexually assaulting inmates. There was one inmate on staff events. Domestic Violence Intervention Services (DVIS) received calls from inmates. All events were immediately investigated and are included in the data.

There appear to be no significant problem areas. Adaptations to policies and procedures are ongoing. The inmate's names were redacted to protect the safety and security of the inmates, other inmates, and the security of the facility as a whole.

The review teams did provide valuable information on process system changes to better inform TCSO of events quicker and more efficiently. The team also made recommendations to improve computer processes. All of the recommendations were implemented. Next year we will strive to improve the ability of inmates to report events.

PREA

The Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) was passed in 2003 with unanimous support from both parties in Congress. The purpose of the Act was to "provide for the analysis of the incidence and effects of prison rape in Federal, State and Local institutions and to provide information, resources, recommendations and funding to protect individuals from prison rape." This law applies to all public and private institutions that house adult or juvenile offenders.

The Tulsa County Sheriff's Office is committed to a zero-tolerance standard towards all forms of sexual abuse and sexual harassment between employees, volunteers or contractors and offenders as well as offender upon offender sexual abuse or harassment.

How to report incidents of sexual assault or sexual abuse:

TCSO accepts and investigates reports regarding allegations or knowledge of sexual abuse of offenders from third parties (family, friends, clergy, vendors, contractors, or any other person having knowledge of an incident.
